



# Winter Seasonal Notes 2021

With winter now upon us it is time to turn our attention to those pruning jobs that will set up the garden for the growing seasons.

### What?

Deciduous trees, ornamental fruit trees, roses, hydrangeas, hibiscus, fuchsia, wisteria, grape vines and some evergreen hedges all require pruning over the winter months.

### When and How?

There is a science to this work that promotes better flowering and/or fruiting, and shapes plants to fit well within the garden. Winter pruning of deciduous plants is preferred because it is easier to view the plant frame in the absence of leaves and this allows more accurate cutting. In addition, there is less stress put on the plant while it is dormant over the winter months. Please refer to Yates Garden Guide for details about what to prune, when and how.
